This research analyzes the cohesion on the Mirna and Jessica case in Jakarta Post used descriptive design with qualitative method through Discourse approach. The result of the research on grammatical cohesion used in Jakarta post in the first news, are: promonimal reference "her, their, his, and they", the demonstrative reference "the and that", Comparative Reference "as", Cataphoric Reference "another", Additive Conjunction "and". For the second news are: Pronominal Reference "Her, she, you, they, their", Demonstrative Reference "the", Additive Conjunction "both, and", Adversative Conjunction "but".

The foundation of Grammatical Cohesion used in this article was built Halliday and Hassan (in Shahnaz and Imtiaz, 2014) showed the organized of cohesive resource as: reference, Ellipsis, Substitution, conjunction, and lexical Cohesion. They had been predicted the concept of cohesion can be usefully supplemented by that of register, since the two together effectively define a text. A text is a passage of discourse which is coherent in

these two regards: it is coherent with respect to the context of situation and therefore consistent in register; and it is coherent with respect to itself, and therefore cohesion.

Fatemi (2014: 362) told that cohesion divided into two kinds, they are: grammatical cohesion which is based on structural content, and lexical cohesion which is based on lexical network and background knowledge. It was supposed by Seken and Suarnajaya (2013) that the cohesion of writing or a text, the five types of cohesive devices, namely: reference, substitution, ellipsis, conjunction, and lexical cohesion are used. These five cohesive devices are linguistic features which tie sentences together. These can make a text an efficient means of understanding and help the reader create meaningful semantic unit of the text for textual

interpretation. [he component of cohesion shown in a table below:

The second news are: pronominal reference, demonstrative reference, Additive Conjunction, and Adversative Conjunction. Some kinds of cohesion in the news give the clearly sentences it also states by Fakuade and Sharndama (in Shahnaz, and Imtiaz. 2014) proved that "This use has contributed to having clear reference and retrieval of information on previously mentioned item".

Based on the discussion above, the writer knows that the analysis is not perfect. So, she has some suggestion to the next researcher, they are: Use more article to analyze a research, not just two articles, and Analyze the article not only from grammatical cohesion but lexical cohesion also, and analyze from other approach as semantics approach, pragmatic approach,

etc,

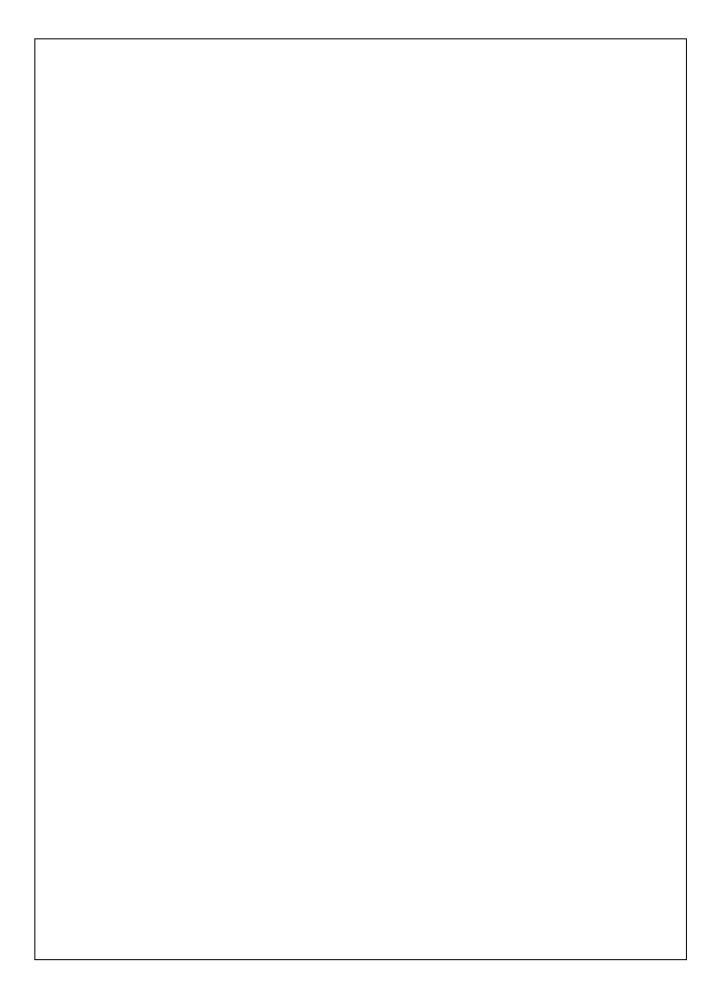
